Small note of the owners

We live in a world of overkill, where sense of time is not respected anymore, where proximity seems only to be virtual: my husband and I needed to work together on a project with meaning...:

- Bringing back time, reconnection to oneself and others,
- Bringing back simpleness that became a lost privilege,
- Allowing one to (re)discover little things to enjoy through activities to share together

Connect people to one another, show and share my contacts and environment... this could be perceived as naive, but this is what my life philosophy is: re-learn how to take time to be in harmony with oneself, take care of oneself, share with others with kindness, simply to enjoy pleasant moments with them and celebrate life...

Since all of this is not that easy in our world, it is important to give yourself some time and to meet people that will help you in that way. I would be delighted to help you organize your stay as best as I can.

The first "help" we got for our project was the trust of Sophie, Nathalie and Virginie Petesch, who enabled us to rehabilitate their family house into living places. This is a generation story that we are proud to share through Sophie's testimony that is filled with tradition, simplicity, authenticity... We are hoping to keep this spirit over time...

"What can we tell you about our story in Cusey?

We got this house from our paternal grandparents who bought it in 1922 (one century ago!), without the Baron's house at that time. Our grandmother was born in Cusey, in a house located in the Rue Haute. Her father was a blacksmith, her mother was a midwife. They lived in this house during their retirement. Our grandmother stayed until 1968 and our grandfather until 1960. We have few memories of him, he was a distant and intimidating old man who, in order to avoid the bustle of a horde of kids, used to having a nap in the middle of his 4 beehives located in the small garden, against the "Baron's wall" (nickname of the former owner) in the middle of our grandmother's roses!

As we were kids, we spent most of our time there for the holidays. At that time, the everyday comfort was quite Spartan, especially during Spring breaks, a time of the year that still is cold in ths region: cold water for the grooming, hot bricks in the bed et toilet in the back of the barn... Fortunately for them, our kids enjoyed more comfort!

We are delighted to know that this old house, a former post house, will begin a new chapter with you and we wish you a beautiful success story with your project for this year 2022 and the coming ones."

The house of the "Baron" is the "A Ciel Ouvert" rental cottage and the initial house (a former post house) is the "La Cour Intérieure" cottage.

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
How to get to the housing address → 1 rue en Janin 52190 CUSEY

For some GPS, the address of our rental cottages will be the former name of the street: 1 rue du Petit Cornot


If you arrive by highway A31 exit n°5, Til Chatel: turn to the right, in the direction of Langres N974 for 15km.



In the village of Vaux sous Aubigny, after the bakery, the tobacco shop and shop Vival, turn to the right in the direction of Cusey for 5.5 km.




<u>If you arrive by highway A31 exit n°7 "Langres Nord",</u> drive through the village of Flagey, then Longeau (9 km). At the roundabout, turn to the right in the direction of "Villegusien, Prauthoy, Vaux sous Aubigny". At the entrance of Vaux sous Aubigny, after the optician shop, turn to the left.



At the entrance of Cusey, continue straight ahead and turn to the left, before the church,



At the stop sign, turn to the left → "Toutes directions" and drive up to the "rue basse"



At the crossroad, turn to the left



Then turn to the right

Handing over the keys, arrival and departure time, situational analysis

The arrival time generally happens between 4pm and 7pm. Please, tell us about your arrival time at + 33 6 22 78 62 86 because we wish to welcome you and give you the keys in person. Thus, we could make you visit the place, do the situational analysis together and answer your questions regarding the functioning of the cottage.

Please, tell us about your departure time as well, so that you can give us the keys in person, and we can do the situational analysis at the end of your stay.

Departure time is expected at 11am, and according to the next booking, it is possible to leave at 2:30pm.

According to the situational analysis on arrival, the deposit will be returned one week later maximum and deducted from the possible additional costs generated during your stay.



How to pay your stay?

To pay the amount of the stay

On arrival-day, please pay the balance of the renting with the cleaning-fee, the tourist tax and additional tax by cheque, transfer, holidays vouchers or cash.

Any options subscribed to must be paid no later than the time of departure.

The deposit cheque (made out to me) must be given to me on arrival at the latest, not cashed and returned on departure or within a week maximum, and if necessary, deduction made of the amounts covering damages or loss caused by the tenant subject to inventory and situational analysis at the return of the keys.



Cleaning

The cleaning-fee is included in the price per stay and not per night but for a stay up to 60 euros, it must be paid with the balance of the nights at your arrival.


Towels, bed sheets and cleaning linen are provided and included in the price of your stay.


We would be most grateful if you could put them at the foot of the washing machine before your departure.

Life rules and functioning of our rental cottages

Functioning of the equipment of the cottages

Appliances user guides are available in the drawer below the oven, with an instruction manual for the provided appliances, which we're asking you to respect.

Broadly speaking,

- For the dishwasher, use the "ECO" program and, depending on the filling, prioritize half a load.
- For the oven, <u>program the type of heat, then the duration and the temperature, and</u> validate (cf. attachment p. 40).
- For the washing machine, use the "ECO" program and wash at 30°/40°
- For the dryer, read the user guide
- For the kettle, choose the desired temperature and validate

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A user guide of "Ademe" is also available in order to encourage a collective, individual and responsible use with recommendations of daily "eco-actions".

Broadly speaking,

- Washable coffee and tea filters are available. Please, empty them in the compost bin located in the kitchen, as well as your food waste. Tea bags are made of flax/cotton, you simply have to empty them in the compost tray and rinse them with running water and let them dry in the open air (tea bags can get stained by tea, but they are still reusable).
- <u>Hand gel and shower gel</u> (body and hair) are available at your arrival. They are ecological and eco-friendly products.
- Sponges and cleaning linen are made up of microfibre and they are washable at 60°C, you can let them dry in the open air.
- Ecological cleaning products are also available, please favor their use. The liquid black soap and linseed oil with lavender essence is multi-use (laundry, floor...). Baking soda powder can be added in the window of the washing machine if the laundry happens to be dirty. Cleaning vinegar can be used as a softener (1 glass in the softener tray), or to clean the sanitary facilities, and it can be used as cleaning product and sanitizer to clean furniture, induction cooking, windows, etc. if diluted into water. User guides are available in the kitchen for the different uses and benefits of those products. In case of any restocking at your initiative, we would be grateful to you to replace them and respecting the natural typology of those products.
- Hydroalcoholic gel is available at the entrance of each rental cottage and liquid soap on each basin and sink in order to respect the sanitary measures. Cleaning alcohol is used to disinfect handles and various objects.

- Thank you for respecting an anti-wasteful consumption of water and electricity (remember to turn the lights off when you are no longer in a room, prioritize "eco" programs for the washing machine and dishwasher) and, if you can, think of the off-peak hours from 2:30am to 7:30am and 2:30pm to 4:30pm.

Life rules

Our <u>rental cottages are non-smoking areas</u>. Outside, thank you for not throwing your cigarettes butts in the yard and garden. Ashtrays are placed everywhere and remember to empty them in the bin once your cigarettes butts are extinguished when you take the garbage out.

<u>For our pet friends</u>: they are allowed if they are clean, do not damage furniture and stay under your responsibility. Blankets are available to cover the sofas and bowls (if you ask for it).

<u>Windows</u>: upstairs, windows that children can reach are equipped with keyed handles and remain under the supervision and responsibility of their parents.

Roof windows are on high ground. For all the windows, remember to close them when you go out or if it rains.

<u>Neighborhood:</u> thank you for not hindering access to neighbors' properties by parking on the sidewalks adjacent to their houses and barns. We also thank you for respecting their peace, especially from 10pm to 7am in accordance with the law.

Garbage and selective sorting

Our civic amenity center is in Prauthoy.

The weekly garbage gathering happens on Thursday morning: remember to take the bins, bags, yellow and blue trays outside on Wednesday evening.

You will get the bin bags at the city hall and the garbage gathering alternates on even weeks: paper, carton... and uneven weeks: plastic, cans... Domestic waste are also gathered on Thursday mornings.

You will find bags for selective sorting on each site, equipped with bags that you will want to take out in the respective yards at the end of your stay.

Our selective sorting system:

Blue bag: carton, papers...

Yellow bag: plastic, tin cans...

Black bag: food waste, glass...

Think smart: in each rental cottage, you will find a compost bin equipped with an odor filter that, at the end of your stay, will be poured in the garden of the rental cottage A Ciel Ouvert (only garden and kitchen waste: grass, peelings...). It will be transformed into natural fertilizer for the aromatic plants at your disposal.

Around CUSEY


Distance: 22.5 km

Time to bike: 1h15

Biking level: easy

This little tour to the Haute-Marne boundaries will lead you to discover the canal between Champagne and Burgundy and the small surrounding villages. You will ride near the Cusey castle (a private site) and will even be able to go back to your childhood by visiting the school of Dardenay (atmosphere of an old-time rural school), where time stopped a long time ago...

→ A former Roman road (North-South direction) is located in the West of the village



The South of Haute-Marne

The South of the Haute-Marne department is well-known for ancient basketry. Indeed, you can find in Bussières-les-Belmont and Fayl-Billot the 20 last basket makers of Haute-Marne. Wicker, which is cultivated there, is still manually worked, it creates traditional objects (baskets, displays, sacks, bread containers, ...) but also pieces of art.

The cutlery art exists in Haute-Marne since the XIVth century, especially in the locality of Nogent. The area counted more than 10,000 cutler workers-peasants. The Cutlery Museum of Nogent promotes fabrications from the XVIIth century to these days.

Thanks to its natural resources: water, wood, iron ore, but also sand, the Haute-Marne department saw its territory covered with steel industries. An ironmaster from the Blaise valley will be chosen in 1681 to provide chimney plates (400) and water supply pipes to the Versailles Castle. Around 1830, in order to diversify its activities, the Haute-Marne begins to develop cast iron art. Among the most famous achievements are the Wallace fountains that adorn the small squares of Paris, the majestic statues that take pride of place in the main towns of the department, the "Art Nouveau" ironworks of Hector Guimard that decorate the entrances of the Paris metro stations and the lamp posts on the Champs-Elysées.

distance: 3.5 km time to walk: 2 hours walking level: easy Ideal for families, the covered way of Langres offers a nice 3.5 km walk, punctuated with architecture and heritage and a beautiful panorama over surrounding valleys. The city of Langres, perched on its rocky outcrop at an altitude of 475 m is classified as one of the 50 most beautiful cities in France, standing like a proud fortress at the gateway to Champagne and Burgundy. Successively Gallic oppidum, capital of the Lingon people, seat of the bishopric and royal stronghold, the city has perfected its armor over the centuries. Each period bringing its touch, transforming the defensive system of Langres into a real history book, retracing 17 centuries of fortifications.

From this long military past, Langres kept an outstanding heritage with 3.5 km of covered way punctuated with 12 towers and 9 gates. Classified as a first category stronghold in the XIXth century, its defensive system developed over a perimeter of 13 km, with a vast citadel and about thirty structures including eight detached forts, nearly making Langres the largest fortified enclosure in Europe...

On the steps of Denis Diderot

Distance: 5 km

Walking time: 2 hours Walking level: easy

The tour "sur les pas de Diderot" offers you to discover the childhood and family of the famous philosopher, in the city where he was born in 1713. As a philosopher and writer of international renown, Diderot left the year he turned 15 to pursue his studies in Paris, but he will always remain attached to his family and his country. Along the way, discover the places he used to frequenting for a long time, such as the "fountain of the Frog", the cathedral or the former Jesuit college, as well as the city of the 18th century. In the square that now bears his name, in front of his birthplace and his childhood house, you will admire the statue made by Bartholdi, which pays tribute to the Father

It has been agreed between the lessor and the tenant that the housing is rented under the following conditions:

1. PURPOSE OF THE LEASE

The parties declare that the present lease is not for the purpose of renting premises for main residential use or mixed professional and main residential use. Consequently, they agree that their respective rights and obligations will be governed by the stipulations of this contract by the decree of December 28, 1976 as amended and, failing that, by the provisions of the Civil Code. The premises, subject of the present contract, are rented furnished on a seasonal basis. The number of people staying on the site cannot be higher than the number written on the contract, we reserve the right to refuse any person foreign to the rental. Any violation of this last paragraph will be liable to lead to the immediate termination of the rental at the expense of the Tenant, the proceeds of the rental remaining definitively the property of the Lessor.

2. DURATION OF THE SEASONAL RENTAL

The Tenant who is signatory of the rental contract linked, concluded for a determined duration, will not be able under no circumstances to take advantage of any right to stay in the premises at the end of the stay. The Tenant expressly agrees to have fully vacated the accommodation at the agreed date and time and to return to the Lessor the keys and other objects or effects made available by the Lessor. At the beginning of the rental period, the Lessor shall hand over the keys and instructions concerning the housing. The Tenant will be given 1 key ring per cottage comprising 2 keys, which the Tenant is prohibited from duplicating.

3. RENTAL PRICE AND CHARGES

5. PAYMENT OF THE PRICE

6. SECURITY DEPOSIT

The Lessor and the Tenant define the following terms and conditions for handing over the keys:

- The handing over of the keys on arrival time and the handing over of the keys on departure time will be done on the site either by the owner or by his representative in accordance with the defined arrival times.
- In order to organize their arrival in the best possible conditions, the tenant will have to contact the owner and/or his representative at least 8 days before the date of his arrival to define the details and the approximate time of arrival on site.

9. SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS AND INVENTORIES

A situational analysis and an inventory of the furniture disposable are given to the Tenant at the establishing of the contract, at the latest at check-in time into the accommodation. 10. DECLARATION OF THE LESSOR

11. OBLIGATIONS OF THE LESSEE

15. RIGHT TO TERMINATION

In case of failure by the Lessee to comply with any of its contractual obligations, this lease shall be terminated by operation of law. This termination will take effect after a period of 48 hours following a simple summons by registered letter which has remained unsuccessful.

16. ELECTION OF DOMICILE

For the execution of the present contract, the Lessor and the Tenant shall elect domicile in their respective residence. However, in case of dispute, the Court of the Lessor's domicile shall have sole jurisdiction. This contract is submitted to the French law.

17. ANIMALS

The contract will specify whether or not the client can stay with a pet. In case of non-compliance with this clause by the client, the provider can refuse animals. In general, well-behaved pets are welcome.




